The aim of the project Jean Monnet Chair Freiburg for European Education is the promotion of basic and in-depth knowledge on European Integration, esp. on European Education. The topic Dealing with Diversity in Education is especially emphasized.

Our main objective is to provide expert guidance to future teachers about European matters, to prepare them to organize learning and teaching processes in a European context. They should be prepared in Teacher Training for the education of the next generation of active European citizens, both theoretically and practically.

There are 3 main areas of our multidisciplinary teaching and research activities:

- Europeanization of Education
- Intercultural Education (esp. Multilingual Education) in Europe
- Education for disadvantaged children (esp. from the Roma-minority) in Europe.



Teaching and training

JMC-FrEE aims to deepen teaching EU studies in the official curriculum of the PH Freiburg, focussing on the topic European Education. It concentrates on in-depth-learning opportunities with a didactic perspective for prospective teachers and other educational professionals to prepare them for their future professional life.

Our in-depth learning offers provide a multidisciplinary perspective of social science disciplines. The seminars are held in English or German. A special focus is on the perspective of (subject-specific) didactics, dealing with the question of learning and teaching about "Europe" in different school forms and subjects in heterogeneous learning groups.

Research

The JMC-FrEE research activities are planned in accordance with the teaching activities and also focus on the aforementioned three areas on different (BA, MA, doctoral and postdoctoral) academic levels. We encourage, advise and mentor the young generation of researchers and teachers in EU-studies, especially in European Education. Students on all levels (especially doctoral candidates) and teachers can participate under conduction, monitoring and supervision of the JMC-team. Research on European matters in school education is a special focus.

Special events

The JMC-FrEE special events aim to involve local, regional and national, but also international participants, from in- and outside of the academic world, such as members of civil organisations, policy makers and other interested members of the public. We put a special focus on involving school pupils (both as active participants and also as audience) of primary and secondary schools in Freiburg, who will need advanced knowledge and competences to be able to shape Europe's future.
