REQUIREMENTS



- Enrolled full-time in a post-secondary, degree or certificate issuing academic institution
 (college/university) outside the USA OR have
 graduated no more than 12 months before the
 start date of the program
- Have an interest in a career in education
- Have sufficient proficiency in the English language to participate in the program
- Be enthusiastic about sharing culture and native language with U.S. students
